The Back Creek Gorge Trail starts at the quiet Blowing Springs Campground and follows the curves of the lazy Back Creek South. The clear creek is stocked with trout and has several deep holes that are perfect for fishing and swimming. The trail thus provides entertainment and access for campground patrons and the public alike. The trail ends at the private land boundary.

The trail begins through the closed gate and follows the stream south, ending on the private land boundary. There is a toilet and hand pump located in the campground. The trail is rated easy and is 1.30 miles long.

NEARBY FACILITIES

The Blowing Springs Campground is quiet and secluded, as well as convenient and easy to access. The campground is accessible to trailers and has picnic tables, a restroom, and a water pump. Back Creek is stocked with trout, but also has a variety of other fish. The deeper parts of the creek are excellent for fishing, swimming, and other outdoor recreational activities.
